Content of the courses

VASCULAR INFLAMMATION AND THROMBOSIS

Organizers: Dr. Pieter Goossens, Experimental Vascular Pathology and Dr. Constance Baaten, Dept. of Biochemistry

Cardiovascular research is increasingly developing into a multidisciplinary effort, and true breakthrough science is often positioned at the interface of two flanking research fields. This workshop will increase your horizon on basic and clinical concepts in vascular biology and thrombosis and will introduce you to (in vitro and in vivo) technologies frequently used in this field.

At the end, you will not only be acquainted with available facilities and technologies in our atherothrombosis cluster (e.g. flow cytometry, animal models, lesion analysis, transcriptomics, microscopy etc.), but also know how to implement these technologies to the benefit of your own research.

DRUG DISCOVERY AND DEVELOPMENT

Organizers: Dr. Matthijs Blankesteyn, Dr. Sébastien Foulquier Dept. of Pharmacology and Toxicology

The process of drug discovery has undergone revolutionary changes during the last decades, with subsequent restructuring of pharmaceutical companies.

What's new? Is the new model of drug discovery going to last? This course will provide you with insights into the drug development process from the identification and validation of a therapeutic target to the final approval of the drug candidate. Researchers with different backgrounds will highlight you the pitfalls and potential hurdles of drug discovery and share their vision for the future of this exciting discipline. You will then work in a team on the design of a drug research project using your recent knowledge, acquired during the course. The goal of this course is to improve your understanding of drug discovery and to give you the keys to build your expertise in this multidisciplinary field.

Entry level and course load

The courses are accessible for all PhD candidates of the Faculty of Health, Medicine and Life Sciences and 2nd year Master students that follow a senior internship at one of the CARIM labs. External PhD students are also welcome to join our course program. The number of credits that can be obtained after successful completion of the course is 1.5 ECTS.

Format of the CARIM Courses

The courses start on Monday and end on Friday. The program of each course varies. **On Wednesday afternoon 5 June 2024 a general session will be organized. The topic of the workshop will be announced in April. All participants to the CARIM courses are expected to participate in this workshop.** This workshop is also open for CARIM PhD candidates not participating in these two courses.

Social activities

A social evening activity will be organized by I'MCARIM on one of the evenings of the CARIM Course Week and the courses will end with a joint gathering on Friday evening.

Registration

Deadline for registration is Tuesday 14 May, 2024. The number of participants is limited to a maximum number of participants per course. The minimum number of participants needed to proceed with the course is 10.
